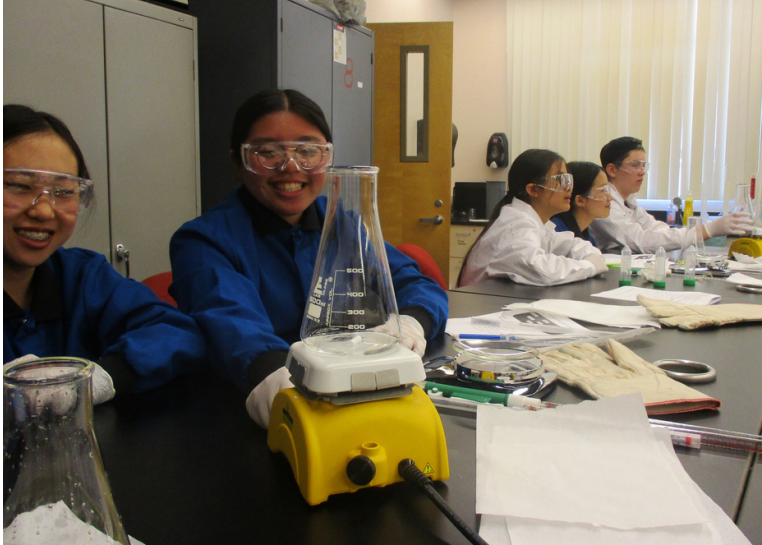

Supplies and Materials

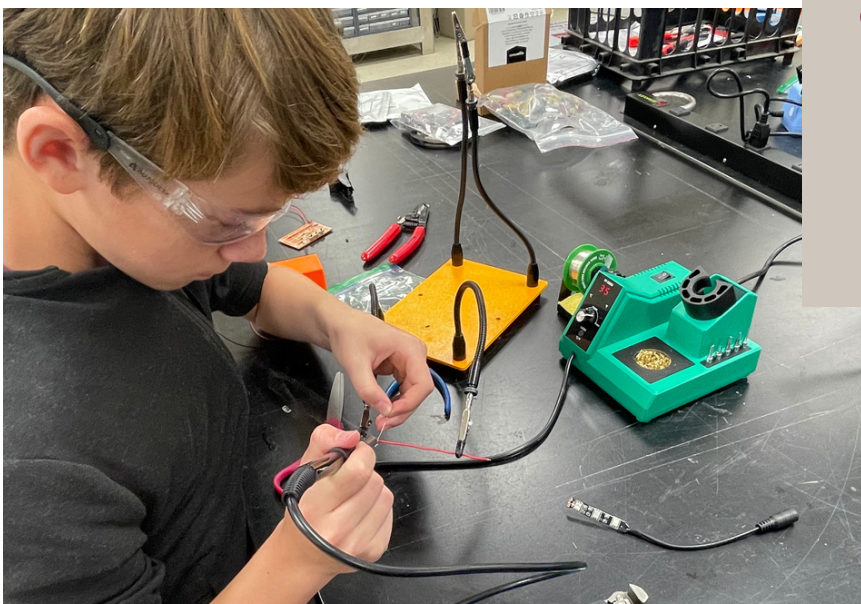
Expenses related to the supplies and materials are dependent on the activity that best serves our students and best contributes to faculty broader impact.
